#### Funding a Foundation

Every society needs a solid foundation of education, religion, a good diet and health care to thrive. The generosity of your direct donations and participation in our fundraisers for the Church of the Immaculate Conception support these key elements for the community of Chauffard. \$45,000 was wired to the bank account for our twin parish in 2024. This amount funded the school lunch program for over 700 students, enhanced salaries for 31 schoolteachers and the lunch cooks, repaired the parish vehicle and provided a salary for the doctors at the medical clinic. This amount is lower than in some past years because the schools were closed for 3 months of the school year. It is amazing how it all comes together. Bottle & can drives = \$11,070. Annual second collection = \$6,208. Book & bake sales = \$4,437. Doug's

To Go events = \$4,272. Mitten & craft sales = \$3,625. Chicken & biscuit dinner = \$2,615. Trunk Sale = \$1,247. Soup supper donations = \$632. We are also funding the Tree Currency Program with support from Raising Hati to reforest the area and improve crop yield and nutrition. \$24,500 was donated directly for that program. This financial support creates the foundation upon which Father Raymond can maintain and grow the spiritual life of his parish. During this difficult time of upheaval in Haiti, the people of Chauffard have improved health, education and faith because of you. Thank you for your support.
