Construction of New Homes Continues

Through your generosity, we have funded the building of 27 new homes for families in our Twin Parish. Father Raymond identifies families who are in need of new homes. They meet many times to set up a timeline. The three-room replacement homes have sturdy, cement brick walls, a cement floor, a metal roof, and should withstand the next hurricane.

Father Raymond orders and picks up the needed cement, rebar and wood from Port-au-Prince using the church vehicle. The family collects rocks and sand, and contributes what labor they are capable of as their participation. Father checks on their progress along the way.



Having a home with a floor, strong walls and a roof will improve the health of a family, beyond peace of mind. We will continue to help with rebuilding efforts as money is available.

School Kitchen Upgrade

In December, we received a \$2,000 donation to fund an upgrade to the Chauffard school kitchen. The kitchen is a small, one-room, cement-block building where the cooks prepare the meals in large pots over small wood fires on the ground. As you can imagine, this kitchen room is smoky and hot. The women have to stoop over while they cook and lift the heavy pots off of the fires. This project is funding the construction of a stand and the cooking gas canisters it will contain, set up so that pots can be placed upon them for cooking at a comfortable height. The project will be completed during the Easter school break. What a difference this will make to the health of our kitchen staff!



Church Repair Project

We are hoping to hear soon that the grant for rebuilding the Chauffard church has been approved by The Papal Foundation. The walls of 70-year-old church are cracking and the timbers are rotting. Father Raymond wrote this month that “from day to day, the situation appears very difficult. The wood is beginning to fall a little, finally. I do not know what to do.”

It is important that the church is rebuilt soon, as the parish’s 70th anniversary is this June.
