Pressing Needs!

Thanks to your generosity, we send \$6,000 every month school is in session to pay for the \$5,000 a month school lunch program at the 5 schools and \$1,000 a month to supplement the 35 teachers' salaries. This fall, we also spent around \$14,000 for the medical mission on medicines and supplies, Haitian staff salaries, room & board, and rental cars.

Spring 2019 brings the 70th anniversary of the founding of the Church of the Immaculate Conception in Chauffard. Incredibly, that means the actual church building in Chauffard will be 70 years old in a few months. Anyone who has seen the building in the past few years can tell you about the cracks in the walls and the rotted ceiling timbers. The foundation is in good shape, but the walls and roof must be rebuilt. This holiday season, please consider a donation to support these projects. Your money can do so much good!

Medical Mission 2018



Our 9th medical mission to Chauffard took place from November 14-21, 2018. Volunteers from Canada and New York State joined with Haitian nurses, Dr. Ralph, and translators to serve over 1,100 patients during 3 busy clinic days. We had 6 returning volunteers and another family pair: nurse Pat Sovocool and her daughter, pharmacy student Rosie Sovocool.

The year-old clinic building was a pleasure to work in. The Mission was scheduled for a week later in November than

in past years to try to avoid the rains and the trouble that they cause with mud along the rough track they travel to reach Chauffard. There was still mud, however, and the 30 mile drive from Port-au-Prince to the village took 9 hours! In the future, Father Raymond is planning projects to improve the route and reforestation of some areas.

Our Guest Dony

We were so happy to welcome our dedicated translator of many years, Dony Pierre-Louis, to Syracuse for a visit in October. He stayed with different Haiti Committee members, saw snow for the first time, visited a local school, went on a boat tour in the 1,000 Islands, picked apples and pumpkins, and ate at many different restaurants.
